### GOVERNING BOARD MADISON, WI

August 10, 2011

The meeting was called to order with 373 Voting Delegates in attendance. Many reports were given and filed. The main issues we tackled were a couple of cost cutting items which included cutting the Travel/Allowance for all of the Rally Chiefs and also the Governing Board Travel/Allowance for the budget year 2012. This resulted in \$57,000 in cuts to the 2012 Budget. One major budget item presented included bringing FMCA'S computer program into the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. It was presented to the board and we overwhelmingly approved an expenditure of \$143,000.

The new Executive Director Brad Koshland gave an over view of what he has done and what he expects to accomplish in Cincinnati in the near future. He has started looking for ways to cut expenses in all areas. A few include Trash Collection, Phone Service, and Office Equipment etc. This has resulted in over \$50,000 annual cuts. He is also looking into Salary cuts and the possibility of renting the Pike Street office, for about \$150,000, and moving the main office to Round Bottom RD. This would result in increased revenue.

A couple of items were approved thru Member Services. Check out the FMCA web page for a \$10 Coupon for Sam's Club membership renewal, United Parcel Service Discount Program and other discount benefits.

The final order of business was to elect the following new FMCA Officers.

## SUMMER OUTINGS OF CCFMCA MEMBERS

### HOW THE SMITH'S SPENT THEIR SUMMER

To our Happy Travelers friends,

No, we're not home! We're sitting in the rain at the Alliant Energy Center in Madison, WI. on our last day here at the FAMILY AFFAIR FMCA RALLY. We are fortunate to be parked near the three main venues and can walk everywhere we need to be. There are over 1800 coaches here (they had planned for 2500). The weather had been great after lots of heat and humidity, but yesterday and today we're having rain with a little thunder and lightning. This a great facility and everything has been going well. In case you are an FMCA member – Charlie Schrenkel was re-elected National President.

We left home June 10th and stopped in Laughlin on our way East. We have been to 20 casinos in 8 states and are about even. We've also been to 39 museums in 9 states. We've seen everything from turquoise to quarter horses, banjos to mustard and the Titanic. We've been to historic Old Towns and RR Stations and a 50's Five and Dime and a diner with great pies, Precious Moments and great frozen custard, cars and planes and tractors, quilts and lots and lots of cheese, Big Texas Steakhouse and Lambert's Café (Home of the Throwned Rolls) and more. We stayed in Peculiar RV Park, Peculiar, MO and Lakeside RV Park in Branson that had been flooded out in April and back in operation (99% of the RV parks have been very good and a few were great). We went to a fun dinner theatre next door to one RV Park we were staying in, have been to several Amish communities and Allyn played tic tac toe game with a chicken and lost, but they sure had a good lunch.

We got to WI August 2 and stayed in a KOA for a week a few miles N of Madison until time to come to Rally. We went to see the House on the Rock and took all 3 tours (one included the largest carousel ever built but all the exhibits are mind boggling), Little Switzerland, and Circus World with a great one ring show and other buildings. We got our generator fixed (exhaust manifold came loose), spent time with our friends who live here, and went to the Sat. Farmer's Market on the Square surrounding the State Capitol (very large and all WI grown). Have been to a Supper Club and eaten Bavarian/German several times. Lots of cheese and sausage and brats, Madison is a lovely city with lakes and parks, lots of greenery, a good economy and nice people. In case you wanted to know, WI will harvest this year 3.28 million acres of corn (522 million bushels) and 7.43 million bushels of soybeans according to the newspaper. It's stopped raining and is in the 80's as is the humidity.

We plan to stay around a few more days to visit with our friends before we start west for home. We expect to be home about Labor Day.
