



The Sierra Ramblers were formed in April 1991. Our Chapter is open to anyone who is a member of FMCA and owns at least 1/3 of an FMCA approved coach. You do not have to own any certain brand of motor home, just as long as it is considered a motor home. We have new motor homes, old motor homes, big motor homes and small motor homes.

We meet every other month, February, April (Chapter Anniversary), June, August, October and December. You are not required to attend a certain number of meetings in a year. We do volunteer each January at the Western Area (FMCA) rally in Indio. Most of our members are from Sacramento north to the Oregon border, but we do have members from the S.F. Bay area, south of Sacramento, Southern California, Arizona, Oregon, and some full timers.

Our dues are \$15.00 a year. When you apply for membership there is a fee of \$30.00. This fee includes the first year dues, your badges and also patches that can be put on a Chapter jacket or a hat. We have a newsletter, "The Sierra Messenger" which is published bi-monthly. In our newsletter you can read about what happened at the last rally, and also see the schedule for upcoming rallies. Sometimes the rallies start on a Wednesday and other times on a Thursday, ending on Sunday morning. Most of our rallies are held at fairgrounds, but once in awhile we go to a private campground.

If you would like to attend a rally just to see what we are like, you are more than welcome to come see if we are a group you would like to be part of. You do not have to join to come to a rally to "Check Us Out".
